The MSTyr15 project was designed to help deliver the intended economic and environment benefits of REGULATION (EC) No 1222/2009 on the labelling of tyres by increasing the rates of product compliance with it.

The team, consisting of 15 Market Surveillance Authorities (MSAs) from across the EU and PROSAFE, has organised coordinated monitoring, verification and enforcement activities, including product testing of Class1, passenger car tyres, between March 2016 and May 2018.

Within the project, labels on more than 12,000 models of tyres have been examined, documents have been inspected and a number of tyres tested. The surveillance authorities have discussed results with economic operators and professional stakeholders, and have taken actions in respect of non-compliant tyres. The authorities have worked together to develop and adopt best practices and establish collaborative approaches to improve product compliance in the EU market.

What are the final results, lessons learned, actions taken, and plans for the future?
